The MICR III is a compact robust encoder that easily meets your requirements for accurate and reliable MICR exception item encoding. Simply key-in the information and drop the document in the track. The MICR III will encode the MICR code-line exactly to ANSI specifications required for check processing. With the footprint the size of a piece of paper, the MICR III allows you to program functions directly through the keyboard, snap in a ribbon, and begin encoding with minimal operator training.
